R/Sir,

With reference to above subject, I have to inform you that, by filing of above said Public Interest Litigation, the petitioner who is Member of Parliament of Aurangabad Constituency has prayed before Hon'ble Court that, Respondent/State Authorities may kindly be directed to fill in the vacancies as specified in paragraph no. 4.10 and 4.12 in respect of vacancies in Government Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad as well as Government Cancer Hospital, Aurangabad, Civil Hospital, Chikhalthana, at Aurangabad, Super-speciality Hospital, and vacancies in Health Department of Zilla Parishad/Municipal Corporation about Doctors, Nurses, staff etc. in Aurangabad.



The above said petition listed before Hon'ble Court today i.e on 07.05.2021.
Upon hearing parties Hon'ble Court was pleased to pass following order.

"Heard. For the reasons recorded and oral instructions as received from the Director of Medical Education and Research Department, we expect the State Government to initiate process for filling up vacancies within a week from today and to take emergent steps to fill in vacancies as far as possible expeditiously.

We hope and trust that within six to eight weeks such vacancies shall be filled in. The State Government shall not treat this Public Interest Litigation as adversary litigation and take steps for making good the vacancies and infrastructure.

The respondents shall file detailed reply on the averments as regards vacancies as there is some discrepancy in the figures as quoted in the PIL and as provided through the Dean, Government Medical College, Aurangabad. The reply shall also deal with the steps being taken for filling up vacancies and as regards necessary ramping up infrastructure. Stand over to 14.06.2021."

You are therefore requested to depute responsible officers along with relevant record and necessary instructions in the matter for filing reply affidavit on or before 07.06.2021.
